Mitigations Updates

- Hand sanitizing stations remain in place in every room in the district. Proper hand washing
 will be encouraged throughout the day.
- Masks are expected to be worn when visiting the health office.
- Isolation of positive cases remains the same:
 - Positive cases isolate for 5 days
 - On days 6-10 masks are expected to be worn while in school.
 - On days 6-10 students will eat lunch in a designated area where 6 feet of separation can be maintained.
- **Voluntary testing** will be available weekly on Wednesdays 4:00 8:00 p.m. at Martin Elementary School.
 - Students & Staff who opt-in will be able to test weekly for free
 - Take home tests will be available to <u>all</u> interested students and staff for at home collection and drop off at Martin location during Wednesday time slot.
- Most importantly! Students should stay home when they feel sick and communicate
 positive cases with the school nurse.





Positive Case Communication Structures

PK - 5th Grade:

Notification will be **made by classroom** when 3 or more positive cases of COVID are present.

6th - 12th Grade:

Notification will be **made by classroom when 3 or more positive cases** of COVID are present.

District-Wide:

If/when the positivity rates go **above 5% in a given building**, a **school wide notification will be shared**.

While Huntley 158 will no longer maintain a public-facing COVID-19 dashboard, these notifications will still be distributed according to our health services' internal process to identify and monitor positive cases in the school community.





Limited Remote Learning Scenarios

- 1. A doctor's note identifying specific health needs along with a completed, state-approved form <u>is required</u> for a student to access a *Home Hospital Instructional* option.
- 2. Remote instruction during a period of isolation:
 - Elementary Instruction will be provided via choice boards and assigned school work may be requested if absence extends beyond 2 school days.
 - Secondary Asynchronous instruction will be provided and accessed via online learning platform. Students should reach out to their teacher as needed for individual assistance during absence.
 - Special Services Related service providers and special education teachers may elect to provide direct support during absence. Student minutes will be made up upon return.
 - Remote learning will only be available to students isolated due to a confirmed COVID-19 case.
