EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS & FAMILIES

E-Learning Days Expectations & Rationale

Huntley 158 will be utilizing our approved e-Learning plans for all grade levels to be used in the event of inclement winter weather. Rather than exercising traditional snow days that need to be made up at the end of the year, the district will utilize our state-approved plans for a day of remote instruction if snow, ice or cold temperatures prevent us from holding a normal day of school.

In 2019, the state first allowed the use of e-Learning days in order to continue learning during inclement weather, and as a result, Huntley 158 and several other districts began planning for this possibility. With the increased accessibility of remote learning for our students, we now intend to utilize these e-Learning days if necessary for the 2021-22 school year.

Schedule

Students will participate in a modified schedule on these days, which will include five (5) hours of instruction time, as required by the state. Teachers will also be available for student support during regular school hours (8:30 a.m. - 3:25 p.m. for elementary; 7:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. for secondary).

Elementary - Grades PreK-5 | 8:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.

Secondary - Grades 6-12 | 9:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m.

Instruction & Attendance

ELEMENTARY EXPECTATIONS

The student schedule will include a 5 clock hour day, which will include a combination of synchronous and asynchronous activities for core classes, specials, and P.E. Students will receive a minimum of 2.5 hours of live instruction throughout the day. Relevant information and activities will be posted on Otus by 8:20 a.m. and will be accompanied by a communication from your student's teacher.

SECONDARY EXPECTATIONS

The student schedule will include a 5 clock hour day where students will have access to learning for their full course schedule, in all classes, including electives and P.E. courses. Teachers will provide an element of live instruction during each class period and will post all relevant assignments and asynchronous activities on Schoology (formerly Powerschool Learning). Students should communicate directly with their teachers if they have questions regarding the expectations in each class.

SPECIAL SERVICES

All students who receive related services and MTSS supports will continue to receive their scheduled support on an e-Learning day.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance will be taken normally for all students. A student must Zoom and/or log in to class to be considered present.
